Use this checklist to guide you in determining the ability for a plant to survive indoors with lower light conditions. The majority of the boxes need to be checked for "Yes." However, some characteristics may compensate for others. Keep in mind, even if everything is checked "Yes," this is not a guarantee of indoor survival. This list only helps you determine whether a plant might have a better chance at success. Furthermore, proper care and placement of indoor plants will help promote survival.
